A Message from Robert Becht, MBA, JD Chief Executive Officer



After several years on hiatus, I am pleased that we have reinstituted our Annual Report. This report serves to inform and guide those interested in Menorah Life and our overall direction.

This has been an exciting time for Menorah Life as we have seemingly come to the end of the COVID pandemic. At its outset, COVID created much fear and uncertainty as it affected our most vulnerable seniors. No one was left untouched – residents, patients, family members, and staff and their families.

COVID challenged our ability to operate and our ability to serve our senior community. Even so, Menorah rose to the occasion by remaining a vital part of the senior healthcare continuum – working in partnership with local hospitals and physician practices. Over the last two years, Samson Nursing Center has become the post-acute provider of choice for rehab and skilled nursing services. We are the #1 receiving facility from both St. Anthony's Hospital and Bayfront Hospital – the two largest hospitals in St. Petersburg. We had the largest number of post-acute admissions of any skilled nursing facility in the entire county in 2022. This is due to the excellent care being delivered which is also evidenced by our CMS 5-Star rating (Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services) and our Joint Commission accreditation.

While Samson Nursing Center, Toby Weinman Residence, and Weissman Day Center all have beautiful facilities, what makes Menorah special and distinctive are our people. We enjoy a superb leadership team and team members who all believe in our mission and live our values every day. Menorah is a place where life is celebrated and honored – especially for the seniors we serve. It is a credit to our people that we are able to continue to serve, to continue to survive and thrive, in what is clearly the most challenging labor market. Our team is a blessing. I appreciate the hard work and am grateful for the dedication I witness on a daily basis. Our Menorah team inspires and uplifts and tells me the future is bright.




